



1. LEARN MORE | There are endless ways you can learn more about modern-day slavery. Check out the **resources** on setfreemovement.org (go to Get Involved > Resources). Download free curriculum from [A21](#), community justice assessment tools by [IJM](#), information from [Polaris Project](#), and more.

2. RECOGNIZE THE SIGNS | Research websites such as traffickingresourcecenter.org and polarisproject.org to learn how to spot incidences of human trafficking.

3. BE PREPARED TO RESPOND | Memorize the **National Trafficking Hotline #: (888) 373-7888** and call if you see something suspicious. This hotline is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, and there are interpreters who can translate into more than 200 languages.

4. EDUCATE OTHERS | Commit to sharing about human trafficking and the work of the Set Free Movement with at least one person a week or month.

5. BECOME A SET FREE \$30 FOR 30 PARTNER | Please give **\$30 dollars a month** for 30 million people enslaved (or another amount of your choosing). You can give as an individual or get a group of people together to pool funds each month. Give what you can—no amount is too small and every gift has an impact. Start today: give.fmcusa.org/set-free.

6. FUNDRAISE | If you would like to get your campus or community involved in **financially supporting the work of the Set Free Movement** and/or a local anti-trafficking agency, consider hosting a documentary screening with a collection taken afterward, a 5km walk/run, a steak night (or a gluten-free vegan burger night!) at a local restaurant, or another event.

7. SHOP SMARTLY | **Vote with your dollar** for the kind of world you want by **purchasing ethically-sourced products** that empower instead of enslave the laborer. Shop at [Heavenly Treasures](#) and [SEED](#), which create jobs for those without viable economic opportunities, or buy survivor-made goods at [TO THE MARKET](#) or [Fashion and Compassion](#). Check out [Better World Shopper](#) for even more information about ethical purchasing.

8. DEMAND MORE | Speak to your **local business owners** about considering making the switch to selling and using fair trade products. Show them the website [Made in a Free World](#) to help your case and encourage them to use the “Slavery Map” option on the site.

9. PROTECT CHILDREN | Prevent trafficking by reaching out to kids who are vulnerable to exploitation. You can sign up to **sponsor a child today** through [International Childcare Ministries](#).

10.
